**First Addendum to
Request for Proposals
Excursion Rail Services**

On January 28, 2008, the Sacramento-Placerville Transportation Corridor Joint Powers Authority (**JPA**) issued a Request for Proposal (“**RFP**”) to solicit proposals from firms and individuals with the experience, knowledge, and qualifications necessary operate excursion rail services along all or part of a 26-mile portion of the JPA-owned rail corridor situated between the “Folsom Wye” (approximately Milepost 111) and the Shingle Springs station (approximately Milepost 137).

This Addendum is to notify potential proposers that the deadline for receipt of proposals has been extended. If you are interested in providing these services, a Letter of Response conforming to the criteria within the RFP must be received by the JPA (c/o Tom Garcia, City of Folsom, Public Works Department, 50 Natoma Street, Folsom, CA 95630) by **4:00 p.m. on Wednesday, March 26, 2008**. The JPA is not responsible for delays due to the U.S. Postal Service, courier services or any other mail delivery service. Proposals received after the foregoing deadline will not be considered.

Apart from the foregoing deadline extension, all other provisions of the RFP remain in effect.
